



**The Bishop's Statement on Marriage has now been published. You can read it on the Notice Board.**

**Each year, 8<sup>th</sup> February** (when not a Sunday) **is the memorial of Saint Josephine Bakhita, the patron saint of victims of human trafficking and modern slavery.** There are 50 million victims of human trafficking across the world and as many as 130,000 in the UK, hidden in plain sight in your neighborhood. Pope Francis described human trafficking as "blood money" and a "crime against humanity". We are all called to combat this evil trade.
